If you are bringing supporters, family or friends, perhaps they would be willing to hold a flag and wear a high viz. jacket. All marshals points have an excellent view of the race and a free lunch! As this is a closed road circuit, the marshals are only preventing pedestrians from walking on to the circuit whilst the race is active.



There are still spaces available up until an hour before the race start time, please book online. The Men's Will Houghton road race at 3pm and the Women's team series road race 1pm. Both races are 90 minutes and there maybe primes in both races but that will be announced on the day depending on entries.

The HQ will be open from 12pm Women's race sign on will be from 12pm and the Men's at 2pm. Please remember to bring your race licence, no licence no ride. Please follow the marshals who will direct you to parking. There is **NO** parking in the **GOALS** carpark. There is additional overflow parking behind the HQ. Please return your numbers after your race.

Sign on will be inside the HQ and will close 10 minutes before each event.

Transponders will be used for the Women's team series race allocated at the sign on, these **MUST** be returned after the race. **There is a £100 fine for non return.**

Both races will be going anticlockwise.
